The TRIANGLE attempted to record the 1967-68 school history without bias. Work began on the 1967-68 yearbook after an eight hour rest from the previous yearbook. In July, the Board of Education selected the name, SANTA FE TRAIL for the unified school district. The new building will be located on the old Santa Fe Trail, now Highway 56. The bond issue carried 760 to 480 on April 6, the third election.

The faculty is pictured as listed in the Employ-ee's Handbook.

An effort was made to consolidate as many school organizations as possible.

The various activities for seniors is recorded on page 138 by school centers.

The staff sold advertisement in August. Each attendance center had its own salesmen. The Triangle is supported by advertising and subscriptions.

Driver Education was offered during the summer as well as the Remedial Reading and a Physical Fitness program. Adult Education was introduced and classes are pictured in this issue.

Advisers to the Triangle were LaVerna Harmon, Ray Shirley, and C. Kennedy Swender.
