Jill Linden, who was sold by mistake at one of Toppings one cent sales, starts to come in, but changes her mind and leaves again.

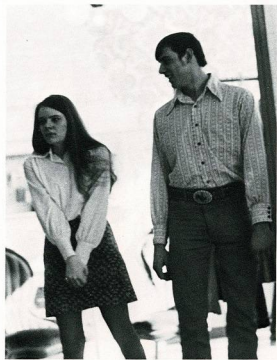
